Instructions for preparation:**Calculations:****Directions:**

1. Prior to crushing tablets in a suitable mortar, add a small amount of Ora Plus to cover tablets and allow to soak for 15 minutes.
2. Mix well and levigate to form a viscous, but smooth and uniform paste.
3. Continue adding all the Ora-Plus geometrically, mixing well after each addition until the contents are pourable.
4. Pour into graduate.
5. Rinse mortar with Ora Sweet SF, adding rinse to graduate, until almost final volume.
6. QS to final volume with Ora Sweet SF. Stir well.
7. Transfer to final closure container and shake to mix well.
